

Report of the Tax Collector  
as of April 30, 2018

- April deposits were \$15,361.90, reflecting \$7,456.24 from Hebron current year taxes, \$6,223.69 from Lebanon in current year taxes, \$265.82 from Hebron prior year taxes, \$752.24 Hebron interest, \$120.00 Hebron lien fees, \$7.33 from Lebanon prior year taxes, \$512.58 from Lebanon interest, \$120.00 Hebron lien fees and \$24.00 in Lebanon lien fees.
- Year to date taxes collected are \$205,539.40 Hebron: \$84,972.69.  
Lebanon: \$120,620.71.
- The combination late notice and notice of intent to lien went out in April with a 4/30/18 deadline. Several additional payments arrived in May with April postmarks. Those amounts are not included in the figures above. May deposits to date are \$4,424.39.
- Several residents requested that we sent notices to delinquent property owners more often. I suggested they attend the annual meeting and propose that we allocate funds for additional mailings.
- The Grand List for Hebron is \$45,117,985.
- The Grand List for Lebanon is \$34,708,140.
- Attorney Laura Cardillo of Pullman and Comley is working on coding the District owned properties as exempt status municipalities. If successful, this will reduce our tax obligation to the Towns by approximately \$20,000.
- Notices of taxes due will be posted in both Town Halls as well as on the District signboards next month.
