

Report of the Tax Collector
As of November 30, 2018

- November deposits were \$1,750.99 reflecting \$578.21 from Hebron current year taxes, \$989.31 from Lebanon in current year taxes, \$31.87 in Hebron prior year taxes, \$35.22 Hebron interest, no Hebron lien fees, \$98.26 Lebanon prior year taxes, \$18.12 Lebanon interest and no Lebanon lien fees.
- Year to date collections through October are \$124,490.18.
 - Hebron: \$51,569.85;
 - Lebanon: \$72,920.33.
- Adam Cohen is moving forward with tax sales on two properties as joint enforcement with the Town of Lebanon. The auction is scheduled for January 17th at 10:00 AM at the Lebanon town hall. Information about the sales is posted in the window at the clubhouse as well as at www.cttaxsales.com.
- Notices that taxes are due January 1, 2019 have been posted on the community sign boards and the clubhouse as well as at both Town Halls.
- The M1 filing for OPM was submitted and accepted. That report is used by the State to determine aid to municipalities. Because we don't receive funds from the State, I haven't submitted the form in the past but it is required by OPM. Going forward it will be filed each July.
