

Report of the Tax Collector
as of December 31, 2018

- December deposits were \$5,837.96 reflecting \$783.16 from Hebron current year taxes, \$3,265.46 from Lebanon current year taxes, \$0 in Hebron prior year taxes, \$15.63 Hebron interest, no Hebron lien fees, \$1,163.71 Lebanon prior year taxes, \$465.40 Lebanon interest and \$144.00 Lebanon lien fees.
- Year to date collections through December are \$130,327.54.
 - Hebron: \$52,368.54;
 - Lebanon: \$77,958.90.
- All four accounts that were turned over to Adam Cohen for collection have been paid in full. The upcoming tax sale has been cancelled.
- Notices that taxes were due January 1, 2019 have been posted on the community sign boards and the clubhouse as well as at both Town Halls. They will remain in place through February 1st.
- The email notice that taxes are due has been very effective. Because our taxes have gone down a number of taxpayers paid for the entire year in July and do not owe for January. It's been nice to return calls and emails to let people know that no payment is due. I've also returned payments to people who thought they had a balance due.
- I will be attending the Connecticut Certified Municipal Collectors meeting in March.
