## Report of the Tax Collector as of June 30, 2018

- June deposits were \$2,210.60, reflecting \$784.64 from Hebron current year taxes, \$965.70 from Lebanon in current year taxes, \$0 from Hebron prior year taxes, \$98.30 Hebron interest, \$72.00 Hebron lien fees, \$122.78 from Lebanon prior year taxes, \$143.18 from Lebanon interest, \$72.00 Lebanon lien fees and \$24.00 Hebron lien fees.
- We finished the fiscal year with \$206,505.22 collected. The breakdown is:
  - Hebron \$86,062.86;
  - Lebanon \$120,408.66.

The final figure includes \$2,748.69 in interest, \$295.12 lien fees and \$3,419.36 in jeopardy collections.\*

- July payments are coming in briskly.
- I've discussed delinquent properties with Adam Cohen. We will select properties for collection enforcement after August 1<sup>st</sup>.
- The transmittal for our final posted ratebook has been submitted to Quality Data Service. We normally get it in September.
- I will try to meet with Laura Cardillo from Pullman and Comley in August to pursue abatements for taxes due to the towns.
