

Report of the Tax Collector
March 31, 2019

- March deposits were \$1,167.71, reflecting \$459.79 from Hebron current year taxes, \$280.52 from Lebanon current year taxes. Prior year taxes: Hebron \$0, \$31.33 Hebron interest. Lebanon prior year taxes were \$292.52 and \$80.07 Lebanon interest. There was only one lien fee for \$24.00 which was paid in Lebanon.
- Year to date collections through March are \$153,547.27.
 - Hebron: \$57,349.59;
 - Lebanon: \$96,197.68.
- *Notice of Intent to Lien/ Demand Letter* went out at the beginning of April. The response has been good. Many of the inquiries I've had are from new owners of properties on the lake. I have reached out to both the Hebron and Lebanon Assessors to see if we can get more frequent transfer updates.
- Once the May 1st deadline referenced in the delinquent notices passes, I'll review accounts to be turned over for collection.
- Liens will be filed in May.
- Both Hebron and Lebanon have finalized their Grand Lists. I will contact QDS to download the Grand Lists to our system. I will make the adjustments for properties partially in the District as well as District-owned properties.
- Once the mill rate is set at our annual meeting in May, our bills can be printed and mailed.
