

Report of the Tax Collector  
as of March 31, 2018

- March deposits were \$3,240.82, reflecting \$1,838.39 from Hebron current year taxes, \$687.99 from Lebanon in current year taxes, \$402.62 from Hebron prior year taxes, \$236.95 Hebron interest, \$72.00 Hebron lien fees, \$0 from Lebanon prior year taxes, \$26.87 from Lebanon interest and \$48.00 Hebron lien fees.
- Year to date taxes collected are \$190,231.5 Hebron: \$76,378.39.  
Lebanon: \$113,853.11.
- The combination late notice and Notice of Intent to Lien went out at the beginning of April. This has generated a flurry of activity. April deposits to date are \$11,649.94 (not included in the totals shown above.)
- Several residents requested that we sent notices to delinquent property owners more often. I suggested they attend the annual meeting and propose that we allocate funds for additional mailings.
- Both Hebron and Lebanon have finalized their Grand Lists and QDS is preparing the adjusted Grand List for the District. The Grand List will be ready for the annual meeting so that we can set the mill rates once the budget has been approved.
- I've spoken to Attorney Adam Cohen regarding real estate the District pays to Hebron and Lebanon taxes. We are exploring the possibility of having the Town taxes waived which would result in significant savings to the District.
