

Report of the Tax Collector
Dated March 23, 2017

- February deposits were \$4879.33 reflecting \$2068.11 from Hebron, \$2616.61 from Lebanon in current year taxes, no Hebron prior year taxes, \$73.73 Hebron interest, no Hebron lien fees, \$1.21 from Lebanon prior year taxes, \$95.67 Lebanon interest and \$24.00 in Lebanon lien fees.
- Tax collection for the year to date: \$163,746.93
- March collections are slow but the combination Delinquent Notice and Notice of Intent to Lien mailing will go out April 1st. Typically this promotes a surge in past due payments. This reduces the postage cost to the District but we may need to send an additional mailing in the middle of May.
- Adam Cohen is also handling the joint tax foreclosure with the Town on two properties in Hebron. He is moving forward to schedule a tax auction June 8th.
- I have received the request from Quality Data Services to let them know how we would like our bills to go out this year. I would like the Board's input as to what to order. My suggestion is that they do the mailing the same as last year (i.e. no payment envelope which costs extra, no tracking included which also costs extra and no additional inserts).
