

Report of the Tax Collector  
Dated April 12, 2017

- March deposits were \$1790.53 reflecting \$725.72 from Hebron, \$392.10 from Lebanon in current year taxes, no Hebron prior year taxes, \$45.85 Hebron interest, no Hebron lien fees, \$419.63 from Lebanon prior year taxes, \$159.23 Lebanon interest and \$48.00 in Lebanon lien fees.
- Tax collection for the year to date: \$165,537.46. Hebron: \$70,156.17 and Lebanon: \$95,371.31.
- March collections were slow but the combination Delinquent Notice and Notice of Intent to Lien mailing went out April 3<sup>rd</sup>. This has promoted a surge in past due payments.
- Adam Cohen is also handling the joint tax foreclosure with the Town on two properties in Hebron. He is moving forward to schedule a tax auction June 8<sup>th</sup>.
- I have instructed Quality Data Service to continue to process the bills as in the past.
- Both the Hebron and Lebanon Grand Lists are ready. I'll work with Ivana from QDS to get all adjustments done and have the Grand Lists loaded and ready before the annual meeting. Once the mill rates are established at the meeting we will be prepared to print and mail the bills. Ideally I would like them mailed early, i.e. in the first or second week of June but that is beyond our control.
