

Report of the Tax Collector
as of June 30, 2019

- June was a slow month for revenue but a very busy month in other respects. The deposits totaled \$785.31, including \$606.04 in current year tax, \$83.27 interest and \$96.00 in lien fees. All June collections were for taxes on the Hebron side of the lake.
- July collections have been brisk.
- Collections through the end of the fiscal year are \$167,200.43.
 - Hebron: \$64,892.34;
 - Lebanon: \$102,308.09.
- As shown above, liens continue to be an effective collection tool. Four of the liens filed after the Annual Meeting were paid in June.
- The notices for taxes coming due remain at the Hebron and Lebanon Town Halls as well as on the signboards around the lake.
- The M-1 report which was filed with the Office of Policy and Management for the State of Connecticut needed to be revised but was submitted well before the July 1 deadline.
- I've had a number of inquiries about viewing and/ or paying bills online. I'll research the feasibility of adding online services in the fall so that it could be implemented for the January installment. I know that QDS hosts online services for other towns and the taxpayer is charged a convenience fee but I don't know if the municipality is charged as well or if they have an arrangement with TD Banknorth.
