

Report of the Tax Collector
as of August 31, 2019

- For the month of August I posted \$23,209.41, representing \$10,885.51 from Hebron 2018 GL, \$25.89 Hebron current year interest, \$12,006.62 Lebanon 2018 GL, \$127.39 Lebanon current year interest. Prior year taxes were \$805.07, prior year interest \$152.19 and \$144.00 in lien fees. Deducting \$235.58 for a bounced check fee (Hebron, see below), the total for August was \$22,973.83.
- Collections year to date: \$116,719.10
 - Hebron: \$46,651.71;
 - Lebanon: 70,067.39.
- John Matra sent two checks for \$235.58 (payment in full) and stopped payment on one. I had to reverse the second check after it had already been posted. Since the bank charged us a \$20.00 fee I billed him but he has not yet paid.
- I've submitted the transmittal for the final posted ratebook to QDS. It will arrive in September. It can be downloaded but my current computer cannot handle a file that large. I look forward to using the new computer the District purchased once it is configured to process taxes.
- I was contacted by Attorney Adam Cohen to join with the Town of Lebanon in foreclosures that he is conducting. The District has been added to the Town proceedings:
