

Report of the Tax Collector  
as of September 30, 2019

- September was a slow month for tax collection. I posted \$883.42, representing \$541.80 from the Hebron 2018 GL, \$20.46 in Hebron current year interest, \$23.20 from the Lebanon 2018 GL, Lebanon prior year taxes were \$230.28, interest was 43.68 and \$24.00 in lien fees.
- Collections year to date: \$117,838.10:
  - Hebron: \$47,449.55;
  - Lebanon: 70,388.55.
- Because of a delay in the printing of our Final Posted Ratebook at QDS, we did not receive it until the beginning of October but they were able to provide an electronic copy in September. I have been assured that this would be a one-time occurrence.
- Adam Cohen continues to work with the Town of Lebanon on the joint foreclosure enforcement on the eight properties in the District.
