

Report of the Tax Collector As of June 30, 2020

- June deposits were \$6,177.97, representing \$1,927.23 Hebron current year taxes, \$1,366.01 Lebanon current year taxes, \$1,089.96 Hebron back taxes, \$400.78 Lebanon back taxes, \$823.65 Hebron interest, \$354.34 Lebanon interest, \$144.00 Hebron lien fees and \$72.00 Lebanon lien fees.
- Total collections for the 2019-2020 fiscal year were \$165,783.98.
 - Hebron: \$64,364.43.
 - Lebanon: \$101,419.55.
- Liens and release were filed in both towns. The total number of liens filed in Hebron was 28. In Lebanon there were 35 liens filed.
- We are now hosted by Quality Data Service which means they have access to our system. In addition we have been upgraded to Version 5 of the QDS software. As is often the case, there were a few issues but now everything has been resolved and we have greatly improved service. Kudos and thanks go out to the staff at QDS for their knowledge, dedication and hard work.
- We also went live with online bill pay through Point and Pay. Again, there were a couple of problems, but we've worked to resolve them. The comments so far have been positive.
- Bills were mailed on June 27th. Payments are coming in briskly, both by mail and online.
- The notices of taxes coming due were posted on the bulletin boards, at the clubhouse and online.
