## Report of the Tax Collector as of September 30, 2020

- September deposits were \$6,151.81, Hebron current taxes: \$2,592.46. Lebanon current taxes: \$3,559.35. There were no back taxes. Because the tax relief program that we offered expired October 1<sup>st</sup>, there was no interest collected in September.
- Year to date collections are \$120,723.95.
  - Hebron: \$47,578.35;
  - Lebanon: \$73,145.60.
- Anita and I still have software problems with QDS. It continues to be very frustrating for all concerned.
- Liz posted the notice that the Governor's Executive Order to provide tax relief due to Covid 19 expired on October 1<sup>st</sup> on our website.
- Additional funds have been made available for the remediation of crumbling foundations but we have not had any applications for properties on the lake.
- The Final Posted Ratebook arrived early in August but as part of the larger software issue was not accurate and had to be done again. The replacement did not separate Hebron and Lebanon and needed to be done a third time. The totals still do not agree with our bank deposits.
