Motion to approve the minutes for March 10, 2021 meeting approved by Kelly Verret and seconded by Kathy Feldman.

General – The Beaches and Rows Committee needs more stewards and volunteers. The white sign and red sign at Main Beach state different dates for no dogs on the beach. The white sign says as of May 1st and the red sign says as of April 1st.

Cove Road – Three boat racks have been stained. The board used at the entry continues to be an issue. A boat rack needs repair and the chain needs to be removed. A silt fence will be installed in the fall.

Oakland - Three boat racks have been stained. The bench needs to be moved to the grassy area of the row.

Ryan Terrace – Two boat racks have been stained. Members suggested reclaiming sand (raking/shoveling sand from water onto shore). A silt fence will be installed in the fall.

Lollipop Beach – Three boat racks have been stained. An estimate to remove and replace the fence around the port-a-potty is being requested

Elsmere – Two boat racks have been stained. Erosion at the shoreline needs to be addressed.

Francis – One boat rack has been stained. The resident has been contacted regarding the collapsing wall and confirmed with the BOD that they will address once they are back.

Meadowbrook - One boat rack has been stained.

Spafford - Two boat racks have been stained. A bush near the left side needs trimming.

Main Beach – Four boat racks have been stained. A steward is needed for the Main Beach. Port-a-potty fencing needs repair/replacement.

Cigarettes on the Beach – A proposal to ban smoking on the beaches and ROWS has been submitted to the BOD.

Spring clean-up – Many residents are not back yet and a few on our committee will not be in town. We will do our best to clean-up as much as possible before the season kicks off. Baldi

has agreed to pick-up after spring clean-up. Spring clean-up primarily involves picking up sticks, removing litter and raking leaves out of the water.
