- June deposits were \$3,411.31. Hebron current payments were \$1,517.90, prior year payments were \$213.06, interest was \$283.94 and there were \$24.00 in lien fees. Lebanon current payments were \$898.97, prior year payments were \$260.89, interest was \$188.55 and there were \$24.00 in lien fees.
- Total collections since 7/1/2021 were \$182,763.16.
 - Hebron: \$85,536.83;
 - Lebanon. \$96,226.33.
- Attorney Adam Cohen is moving forward on tax sales on two properties:
 - 28 North Pond Road, Amston;
 - 114 North Pond Road, Amston.

The tax auction is scheduled to take place on Friday, September 30th at the clubhouse. The warrants have been sent to the Hebron Town Clerk for recording, notices have been sent to the owners and newspaper notices will be published this week. Information is available at www.cttaxsales.com. Now that the process has commenced, I cannot accept payments or discuss amounts due; all inquiries must go through Pullman and Comley. Both Adam and I are confident that the balances will be paid in full to avoid the sale.

- Frank Hoisl, Adam Cohen and I are working with the Hebron, Lebanon and Colchester Assessors to determine an equitable solution to the problem of taxes on the Cormier property which is in all three towns. Adam Cohen believes that we will be able to tax the full property.
