## Report of the Tax Collector As of November 30, 2022

- November deposits were \$745.09. All payments were for the current year. Hebron current payments were \$267.66 plus \$10.00 in interest. Lebanon payments were \$452.84 plus \$14.59 interest.
- Total collections since 7/1/2021 were \$127,304.02.
  - Hebron: \$55,359.08;
  - Lebanon. \$71,944.94.
- I attended the CCMC Fall Meeting at the Aquaturf on November 10<sup>th</sup>. The focus of the meeting was upcoming legislative changes and changes to collecting motor vehicle taxes. The meeting qualified for 2 credits of continuing education.
- Adam Cohen continues to collect on the delinquent taxes assigned to him. I plan to turn over additional accounts for collection after the January 2023 installment.
- I have received requests from escrow companies for the amounts due for the upcoming January tax cycle. Because the information is available online the process has improved.
- I've received the authentication code to complete the 2022 census Survey which must be submitted by December 20<sup>th</sup>.
