

Report of the Tax Collector
February 28, 2019

- February deposits were \$2,526.80 reflecting \$353.83 from Hebron current year taxes, \$2,114.91 from Lebanon current year taxes, \$93.83 Lebanon prior year taxes and \$58.06 Lebanon interest.
- Year to date collections through February are \$152,379.
 - Hebron: \$56,858.99;
 - Lebanon: \$95,520.57.
- The outstanding delinquencies for the current collection year are \$17,506.01.
- I will send the *Notice of Intent to Lien/ Demand Letter* at the beginning of April. I will wait to see the response before turning accounts over for collection. The demands typically get a good response.
- I did not get a single inquiry about applying for the statutory extension for tax payments available to government employees affected by the shutdown in January.
- I will attend the Connecticut Certified Municipal Collectors meeting Wednesday and Thursday of this week.
- I am three weeks into my last CCMC class (Municipal Finance) which runs until the middle of May. After that I will be eligible for certification.
