

Report of the Tax Collector
as of October 31, 2019

- October was another relatively slow month for tax collection. I posted \$2,001.93, representing \$1,116.17 from the Hebron 2018 GL, \$50.44 in Hebron current year interest, \$559.94 from the Lebanon 2018 GL, \$19.54 in Lebanon current year interest. Hebron prior year taxes were \$137.27, interest was \$30.89 and \$24.00 in lien fees. Lebanon prior year taxes collected were \$63.68.
- Collections year to date: \$119,840.03:
 - Hebron: \$48,808.32;
 - Lebanon: \$71,031.71.
- Payments for the January installment have begun to arrive.
- Adam Cohen has collected payment in full on two of the accounts that were turned over for tax sales in a joint enforcement with the Town of Lebanon. Because the funds were not received in October, the totals shown above do not include those payments. He continues to work with delinquent tax payers to make payment arrangements.
- Liens will be released in both Hebron and Lebanon this week.
- I will attend the Certified Connecticut Municipal Collectors semi-annual conference at the Aqua Turf on November 14th.
