

Beaches and Rows Committee Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, May 12, 2021

Meeting was called to order at 6:11 by Teri Nixon

Members and volunteers present: Patty Arnestad, Stephen Bosworth, Kathy Feldman, Kathleen Garvie, Karen Merchant, Marge Nichols, Teri Nixon and Kelly Verret.

Motion to approve the minutes for April 14, 2021 meeting approved by Kelly Verret and seconded by Kathy Feldman.

General – The Beaches and Rows Committee needs more stewards and volunteers.

Cove Road – The board used at the entry to the beach continues to be an issue. Contractor will address the boat rack needing repair and removing the chain link fence in front of the boulders.

Oakland – Contractor will move the bench to the grassy area of the row.

Ryan Terrace – Volunteers would like to reclaim the sand to fix the erosion issue. No mechanical devices would be used. Permission will be requested at the next BOD meeting.

Lollipop Beach – Committee volunteer will provide a design for the beach with retaining walls. Weeds should also be removed from the beach. The discussion of a handicapped port-a-potty was discussed and should be considered based on the American Disabilities Act.

Elsmere – Erosion at the shoreline needs to be addressed and has been brought to the contractor's attention.

Francis – The resident has been contacted regarding the collapsing wall and confirmed with the BOD that they will address once they are back. Follow-up needed.

Meadowbrook – No issues noted.

Spafford – The bush near the left side needs trimming and is on the contractor's list of projects. Chain link fence should also be removed.

Main Beach – A steward is needed for the Main Beach. Port-a-potty fencing needs repair/replacement. The discussion of a handicapped port-a-potty was discussed and should be considered based on the American Disabilities Act. A resident has requested we move a boulder so they can access the parking lot/port-a-potty with a walker.

Cigarettes on the Beach – A proposal to ban smoking on the beaches and ROWS has been submitted to the BOD and will be voted on at the annual meeting – May 22, 2021.

Spring clean-up – Will be handled by the contractor and pick-up by Baldi. Spring clean-up primarily involves picking up sticks, removing litter and raking leaves out of the water.
