

Report of the Tax Collector As of March 31, 2021

- March was a quiet month. Deposits were \$1,075.98; all payments were for the current Grand List year. Hebron payments were \$550.90, including \$435.38 in taxes and \$65.52 in interest. Lebanon payments were \$525.08, including \$491.88 in taxes and \$33.20 in interest.
- Total collections for the 2019-2020 fiscal year were \$150,446.01.
 - Hebron: \$55,069.66;
 - Lebanon: \$95,396.35.
- Delinquent notices went out at the end of March.
- Adam Cohen has contacted eight seriously delinquent property owners to arrange either payment in full or payment plans.
- The Hebron Grand List for 10/01/2020 has been finalized. I am waiting for the Lebanon Grand List. Because it was not a revaluation year for either town, I don't anticipate a significant change in the final totals.
- The State of Connecticut has changed the requirements for the certification of Tax Collectors. We are now required to re-certify every five years by completing 50 credit hours of continuing education. My deadline is not until 2025. I took a class in March on effective internal controls and attended a seminar on jeopardy collection and legislation. I currently have 40 hours of continuing education and I can't foresee any difficulty in completing the remaining requirement.
