

Report of the Tax Collector As of May 31, 2021

- May deposits were \$2,305.87. Hebron payments were \$1,305.94, including \$1,038.25 in current year taxes, \$17.18 in back taxes and \$177.10 interest. Lebanon payments were \$999.83, including \$350.03 in current year taxes, \$322.56 back taxes, \$270.98 interest and \$56.36 in lien fees.
- Total collections since 7/1/2020 were \$159,163.18.
 - Hebron: \$59,452.99;
 - Lebanon: \$99,710.19.
- Adam Cohen is moving forward on tax sales on seven of the eight properties that were turned over for collection. The other taxpayer has set up a payment plan through Pullman and Comley.
- I have hard copies of the Grand Lists from both Town Assessors. I am waiting for QDS to load the lists to my computer so that I can make the District adjustments and corrections. At that point I will enter the mill rates and send the file to QDS for printing and mailing.
- As required by the State, I have filed the M-1 report (Collections and mill rates) well in advance of the 7/1/21 deadline.
