

Report of the Tax Collector

As of April 30, 2023

- April deposits were \$4,938.69. Hebron payments were \$1,260.74 including interest of \$116.56. Lebanon deposits were \$3,677.95 including interest of \$417.09 and \$72.00 in lien fees.
- Total collections year to date were \$162,815.19.
- Hebron: \$66,054.48.
- Lebanon: \$96,760.71.

- Clearly the denial of lake passes for unpaid taxes is a powerful incentive.

- Adam Cohen filed the Tax Collector's Deed for 28 North Pond Road with the Town of Hebron in April.

- Liens and releases will be filed in both towns by the end of May.

Hebron adjusted Grand List: \$56,703,940 (last year: \$56,066,860).

Lebanon Adjusted Grand List: \$37,956,310 (last year: \$37,556,970).

- I continue to update the list of delinquent accounts and send them to Karen Patterson reference for pass distribution. This is proving to be an effective tool to bring taxpayers current if they have outstanding taxes.
