

Report of the Tax Collector

As of May 31, 2023

- May deposits were \$3,404.39. Hebron payments were \$2,196.70 including interest of \$396.29 and \$116.00 in liens and fees. Lebanon deposits were \$1,207.69 including interest of \$139.62.

- Total collections year to date were \$166,219.58.
 - Hebron: \$68,251.18.
 - Lebanon: \$97,968.40.

- The denial of lake passes for unpaid taxes continues to be a powerful incentive.

- Liens and releases were filed in both towns in May.

- I continue to update the list of delinquent accounts and send them to Karen Patterson reference for pass distribution. This is proving to be an effective tool to bring taxpayers current if they have outstanding taxes.

- Because we are hosted by QDS, they were able to make the adjustments to both Grand Lists (properties partially in the District and District owned properties) which I did manually to get the Grand List numbers for our May annual meeting. They also did the back tax coding this year. .

- Credits on file have been applied and our bills are at the printer. Bills will go out at the end of June.

- The M-1 report to the Office of Policy and Management has been submitted and accepted.
