

Report of the Tax Collector

As of September 30, 2023

- September deposits were \$4,386.14. Hebron total payments were \$2,974.74. Of that amount \$844.48 was for the current installment, \$1,262.54 was for prior year taxes plus interest of \$699.92 and \$168.00 in lien fees. Lebanon deposits were \$1,411.20, representing current tax payments of \$1,198.86, back taxes of \$131.35 plus interest of \$56.99 and \$24.00 in lien fees.
- Year to date payments were \$130,068.23.
 - Hebron: \$56,655.26;
 - Lebanon: \$73,412.97.
- The final posted rate book has arrived from Quality Data System.
- The issue with the refund issued in error by the online payment vendor has been resolved.
- Attorney Adam Cohen continues to work on the delinquent properties that were turned over to him for collection. Another delinquent property owner has paid in full; the rest have been notified that tax foreclosure process has started.
- I will be taking a continuing education tax collection seminar in Stonington on October 17th. Because my membership in the Connecticut Tax Collectors Association was through the Town of Andover, I will need to reapply as a collector for the District.
